Specimen Labeling and Patient Identification

All specimens are to be labeled <u>at the time of collection</u> with <u>at least</u> two patient identifiers.

If the label is hand-written, writing must be legible.

- Patient's First and Last Name
- Date of Birth
- Date & Time of Collection
- Initials of Collector

Test Requisition

The requisition, at a minimum should contain the following information.

If the requisition is hand written, writing must be legible.

- Patient first and last name
- Patient gender (M/F)
- Patient date of birth
- Medical record number (MRN) (if new patient without MRN, provide copy of Driver's license and insurance card and patient's contact phone number if available)
- Diagnosis
- Test(s) requested
- Date and time of specimen collection
- Initials of collector
- Source and type of specimen, when appropriate
- Name, address, & signature of physician ordering the test

Check that all required elements are present and accurate.

Match up specimens to test requisition information prior to packaging for transportation.

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
